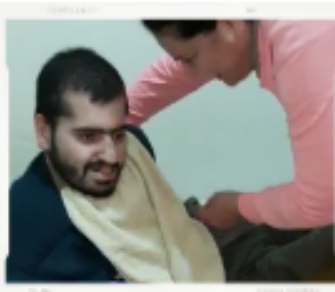

In 2022, Allied Cultures distributed Dignity Kits of essential supplies to the homeless and refugee communities in need.

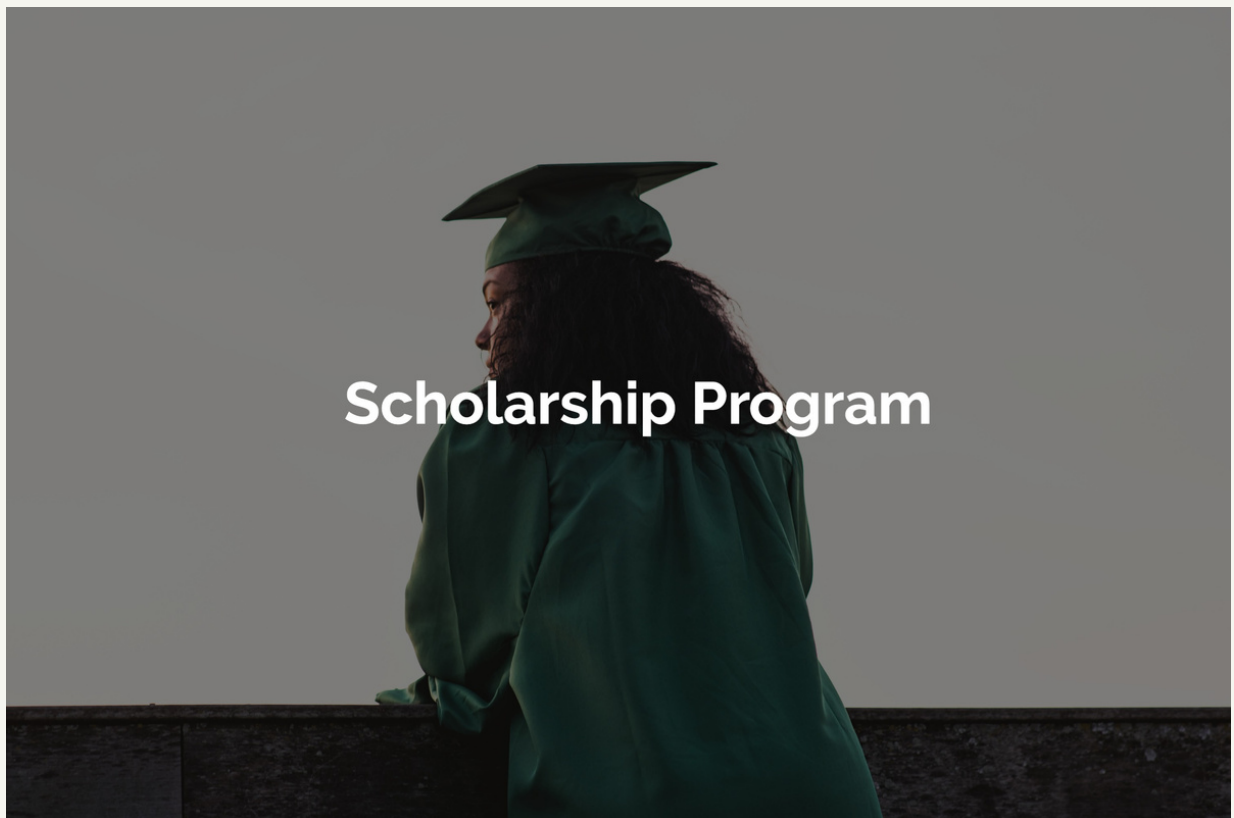

Providing scholarship funding to students seeking to make a difference in this world.

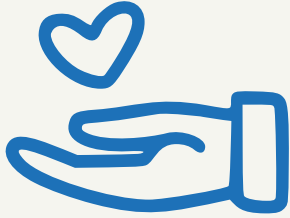
Allied Cultures distributed two \$500 scholarships to deserving students who shared our vision of multiculturalism and diversity appreciation.

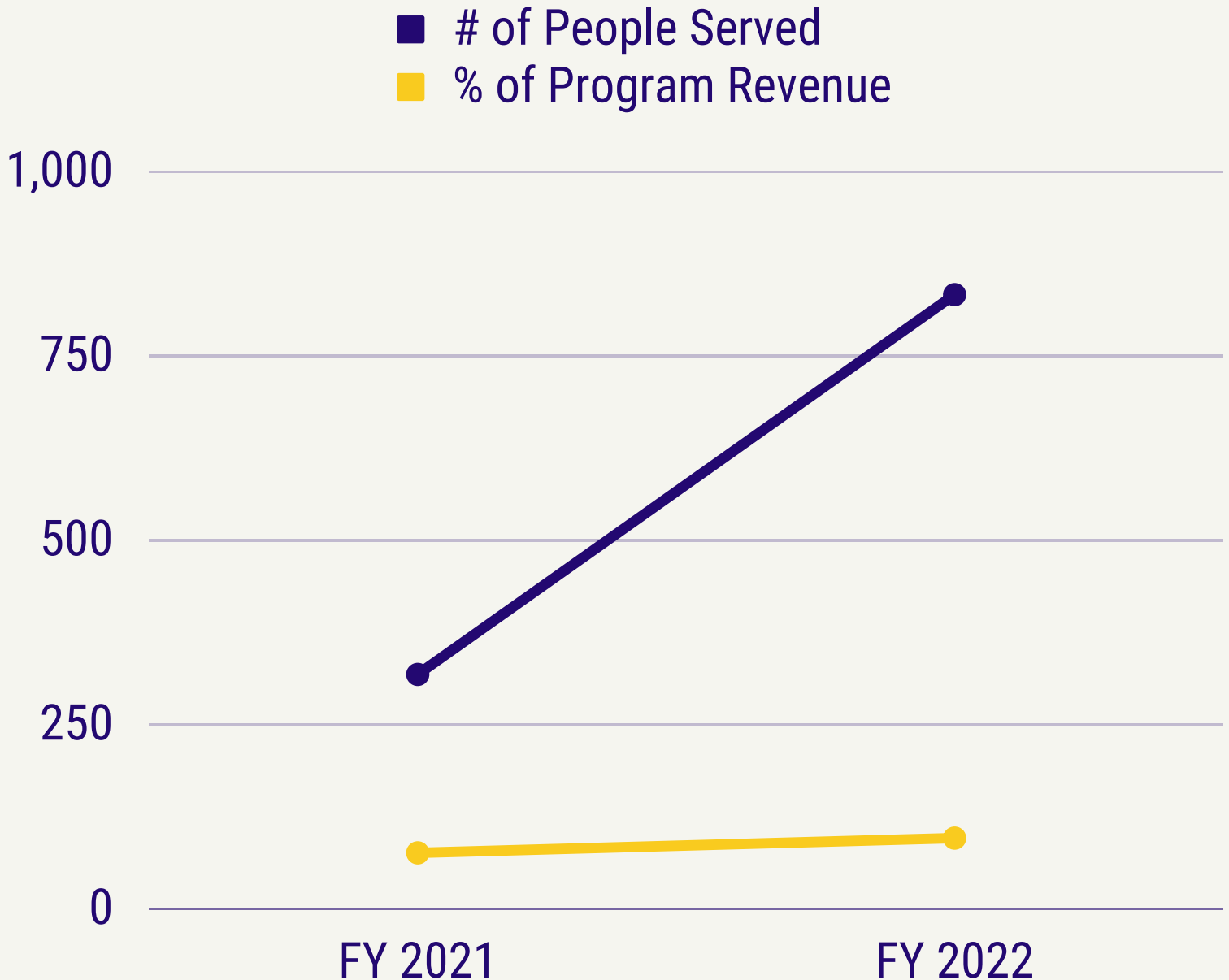
